

WHY READ 1000 BOOKS BEFORE KINDERGARTEN?

Early literacy skills have a lifelong impact of education and occupational success. This program promotes reading aloud to children to foster a love of reading and build strong bonds within families.

DOES THIS SOUND ACHIEVABLE?

If we break it down, it is! If you read 1 book per day for a year that is 365 books per year. In three years that would be 1,095 books! Most children start Kindergarten at the age of five, so there is room to spare.

ANY BOOKS COUNT!

Do your children love to read the same book over and over? Every time a book is read to them, even if it's rereading, that will count each time. Rereading books encourages vocabulary and lets them dive deeper into the theme of the story.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Detach and fill out the registration form and return it to your home branch of Presque Isle District Library.



You will receive 10 pages of reading logs with 100 bubbles of each page. Fill in a bubble with each book read and turn it into your library when the page is full. We love rewarding readers, so for every 100 books read you pick a free book.



Each child will receive a “reading monster” sticker that will move around our 1000 Books Before Kindergarten board as they complete their milestones.



Each child that reaches 1000 books will be celebrated with a gift basket! The real prize will be the stories told and memories made from growing a love of literacy.
